Assembly Third Reading

Dear Senator Wieckowski:

The California State Association of Counties (CSAC) has removed its opposition to your Senate Bill 1069, which would change standards related to the permitting and development of accessory dwelling units. CSAC appreciate the amendments you have taken, which address concerns related to proposed limitations on utility connection fees for ADUs, maintain the 120-day timeline for local agency approval of an ADU application in existing law and applying it whether a local agency has an ordinance or not, and removing the restriction on local government off-street parking requirements when an ADU is near shopping.

CSAC understands that safe, clean and decent housing that is affordable to all income levels is essential to the health, safety and prosperity of all Californians and that the state is reaching a crisis point regarding both the availability of housing and its affordability. ADUs represent an important opportunity to provide additional housing options to Californians.
