AB 2622 (Nazarian) – Property taxation: certificated aircraft assessment
As Amended August 19, 2016 – SUPPORT
Senate Third Reading File

The California State Association of Counties (CSAC) **supports Assembly Bill 2622** (Nazarian) and respectfully requests your **AYE** vote on the Senate Floor. This bill would extend the existing lead county system for certified aircraft assessments for three years, until the end of fiscal year 2019-2020.

The soon-to-expire lead county system was the result of collaboration between the Board of Equalization, the airline industry, and county assessors a decade ago. County assessors have faithfully carried out their duties related to commercial air carrier-owned property assessments using the now well-established and successful methodology. In addition to extending the lead county system, AB 2622 would also make several administrative changes that promote the adoption of best practices and streamlining steps to help minimize burdens on airline industry resources.

We believe that county assessors collectively are the most efficient taxing entities in the state and will continue to serve all parties well in their duties under this measure. For these reasons, CSAC is pleased to support AB 2622 and respectfully requests your **AYE** vote.
