(**Oppose**) – **Held in committee (with editorial comment from the chair: At the request of the author and sponsors, held in committee but commend the work done to address raising health care costs. “I want to be clear that working families can no longer afford the skyrocketing costs of healthcare. No Californian can. This is an that the legislature has to address, if we do nothing, we will bring down our economy, and I would hope that holding it does not stop people from working on this issue because that would be a huge mistake.”)**
